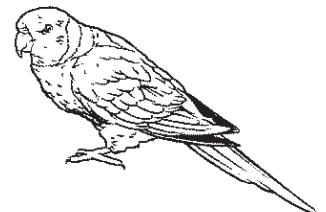

3 PUT YOUR NOSE TO WORK

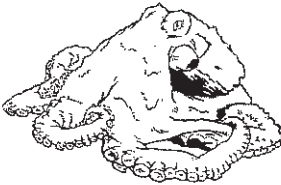

4 TAKE A TASTE TEST

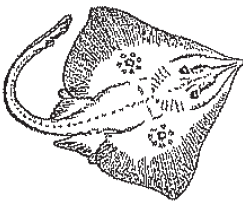
